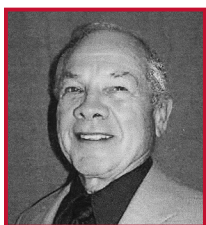

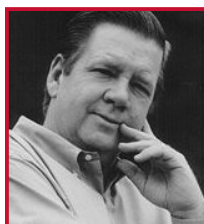
HIS BANNER OVER US IS LOVE "BRING DOWN THE FIRE"



Joseph Cohen

Rev. Cohen was raised in a conservative Jewish home. His friends, work and religion did not fill the void in his life. The emptiness led him to get into the wild life of partying. He enjoyed this until he became a slave to it. All different kinds of drugs including alcohol and barbituates, did not fill the void. Neither did his compulsive gambling. To make matters worse, depression, fear and loneliness led him to write a suicide note.

It was that night before he closed his eyes, he asked God for help. He was afraid to die because he did not know where he would go, but he did not want to live anymore. God answered his prayer, he witnessed his partying friends come to faith in Jesus. He saw a complete change from within. January 8, 1978 in his bedroom he had a supernatural encounter with the living God. God baptized him in the Holy Spirit. Instantly, the void was filled with peace and contentment. All his ungodly desires stopped. God cleaned him up since that day. God broke the spirit of fear, depression and loneliness.



Paul Teske

Rev. Paul Teske's retirement plan was to spend his final years with Rivers, his wife, playing golf and traveling. The Holy Spirit however had other plans. On May 7, 2004, while speaking to two hundred businessmen, Pastor Paul suffered a cerebral hemorrhage, immediately leaving his left side paralyzed. While in the hospital, God spoke to him and told him that he would be healed in twenty-one days. Upon leaving the hospital in a wheelchair, he was told by the medical staff that even after physical therapy, he would need to wear a leg brace for the rest of his life.

21 days after the stroke, Rivers drove Paul to Baltimore, MD to attend a large healing crusade. On that Friday night, exactly as the Lord had promised, Pastor Paul was completely healed. Without any knowledge of his prior condition or healing, the minister leading the service called Paul and Rivers to the platform to receive "a call to administer healing and deliverance" and stated that thousands of people would be healed by Jesus through their ministry.

Since his healing on May 28, 2004, Pastor Paul has witnessed thousands give their lives to Jesus as he confirmed the Gospel with signs, wonders and miracles. He has personally seen a blind woman in Greenwich, CT have her sight fully restored by the power of Jesus Christ.
